Addressing school districts' most urgent needs and significant capital expenditures, the Minor Renovations Program will develop guidelines for school renovations and modernizations that fall outside the scope of established verification systems.



## The Process

As a partner in the Minor Renovations Program, you will collaborate with industry experts to develop industry best-practices for schools' most common facility upgrade needs. You will work alongside building scientists, health and safety representatives, leading manufacturers, consultants, service providers, architects, engineers, educators and leaders in children's health organizations.

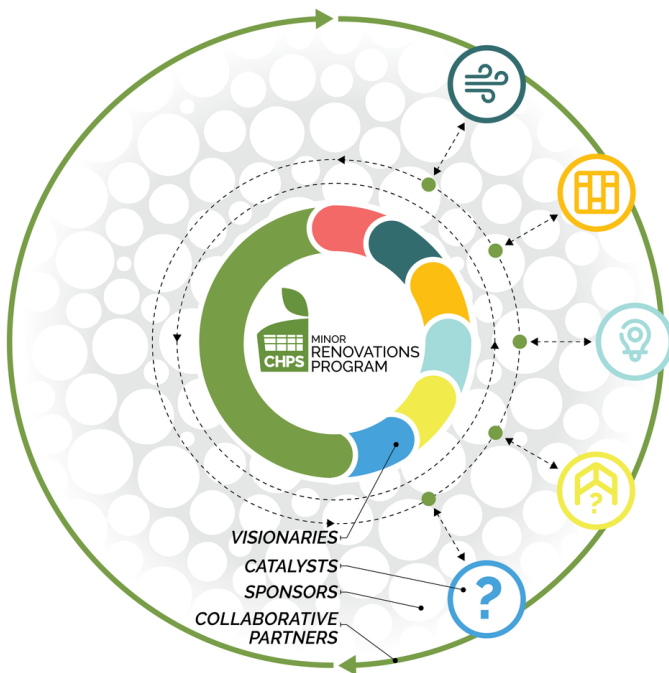
Starting with flooring, lighting and HVAC projects, working groups will adapt existing CHPS' criteria and create a scoring mechanism and tools to assist in applying the standards.

Partnering school districts will use the guidelines in their 2024 scheduled projects and document the use and application. District staff will make recommendations and provide feedback to the criteria and the application process.
